M.M.P.Shah Women's College of Arts & Commerce, Matunga, Mumbai-19 and Department of Commerce of Maniben Nanavati Women's College, Vile Parle (West), Mumbai-56, both affiliated to S.N.D.T. Women's University for conducting a 'Faculty and Students Exchange Programme'.</p> <p>The aforesaid colleges are hereafter known individually 'Institute' & collectively 'Institutions'.</p> <p>I. Objective of MOU: The objectives of the MOU are:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">a) to provide and enhance expression and sharing of knowledge amongst peer students from two different institutions.b) to provide exposure to the students about learning aid & infrastructure of institutions offering same Bachelors programme & specialization, affiliated with same University within the vicinity of Mumbai.c) to inculcate in students competitive skills for enhancing their academic interest.d) to promote research/continuing education activities between both the institutions.

2. About the Faculty and Students Exchange Programme:

- a. The MOU is between the Department of Commerce & Accountancy of Smt. M.M.P. Shah Women's College of Arts & Commerce, Matunga, Mumbai-19 and Department of Commerce of M.N.W College, Vile Parle(West), Mumbai-56 and vice-versa.
- b. There will be faculty exchange from both Commerce and Accountancy Department of each of the institutions.
- c. One faculty each from Commerce and Accountancy will be assigned a topic relevant to their study, for conducting lectures in the other Institution to develop academic interaction by delivery special lectures. This programme will help in enhancing teaching skills of the faculties.
- d. Fifteen students of second year B.Com will be identified by both the respective institutions for purpose of exchange. These advance learner students will get expenses of attending lectures in the other Institute.
- a) The above students will be participating in all the activities undertaken within the purview of the programme and will be entitled for participating certificates. The activities so undertaken will help the students in developing their competency and personality.
- b) The activities to be conducted during the programme shall be decided by mutual consent of Head of Departments of Commerce and Accountancy of both the Institutions.
- c) The Head of Departments reserve right for any change of activity by their mutual consent with each other before the conduction of programme.

3. Proposed Modes of Collaboration:

The Department of Commerce & Accountancy of Smt. M.M.P. Shah Women's College of Arts & Commerce, Matunga, Mumbai-19 and Department of Commerce of Mambhai Nanavati Women's College, Vile Parle(West), Mumbai-56, proposes to collaborate through the following:

- a) Propagation of education and training in the areas of mutual interest.
- b) Co-operation and conduction of various activities with consent of faculty members.
- c) Any other appropriate mode of interaction agreed upon between the Commerce & Accountancy Departments of the two Institutions.
A schedule of activities and conduction will be drafted with the agreement and consent of Head of Departments of both the Institutions along with this MOU.

4. Duration of the Programme & MOU:

The Faculty & Students Exchange Programme shall be conducted between the two Institutions involving exchange of faculties as well as students, in all for one week i.e. six working Days. The undersigned MOU will be valid for two academic year starting from 2017-2018 and 2018-2019. However the institutions can amend or terminate the MOU as or before the expiry of the term of MOU.

5. Terms & Conditions :

- a) The cost incurred for travel of faculties during the Faculty and Students Exchange Programme to and fro from each college and visits shall be borne by both the institutions individually.
- b) The cost of infrastructural utility including use of classrooms, teaching aids, preparatory materials, reference books resources, internet, laptops, OHP'S, Projectors, etc. shall be borne by both the institutions individually.
- c) The expenses relating to the Certificates, Prize, Trophy's, Refreshments, Honorarium expenses for inviting Experts, Judges during the programme shall be borne by both the Institutions individually.
- d) The institutions reserve right to be indemnified for the expenses incurred specifically during the conduction of this programme collectively and equally.
- e) However, the institutions are free to arrange sponsors for part or whole of the programme.
- f) Both the Institutions agree to co-ordinate, co-operate in organizing activities, identifying and inviting the faculty members/ Experts/Judges and arranging for the visits.
- g) The MOU may be amended, renewed and terminated by mutual written agreement of the institutes at any time.
- h) Either institute shall reserve right to terminate this MOU, by giving a written notice of not less than 30 days to the other institute.

6. Confidentiality:

The Institutions entering into the MOU shall agree to hold in confidence all information/data/ records obtained by either of them during the conduction or performance of the programme and shall not disclose any of the material facts relating to the MOU to any third party. Violation of the confidentiality will hold the MOU to be Null and Void.

7. Co-ordinators:

The responsibility for conduction of this programme shall be of the Head of Departments of Commerce & Accountancy of each of the Institutions. They can depute their faculty members for the exchange programme.

DAY 1 & 2

SMT.MMP Shah Womens,s Arts & Commerce college and EduBridge Voltas Kaushal Vikas Kendra will conduct Communication Skills training program for youths in the college.

Both the parties agree to following terms and Conditions:

1. EduBridge Voltas Kaushal Vikas Kendra will offer the Program for students who are willing to enhance their communication skills.
2. On Completion of program, the Second Part will do certification of candidates who have been trained.
3. The Second Part undertakes that the database of students, their personal information, documents, video recordings or any other information noted or recorded during the progress of the training programme, will not be used without prior express permission of the First Part.
