❖ **HOSPITALITY**

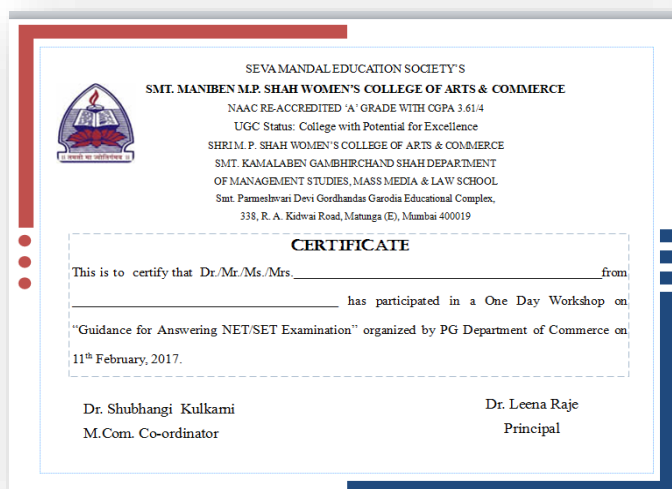

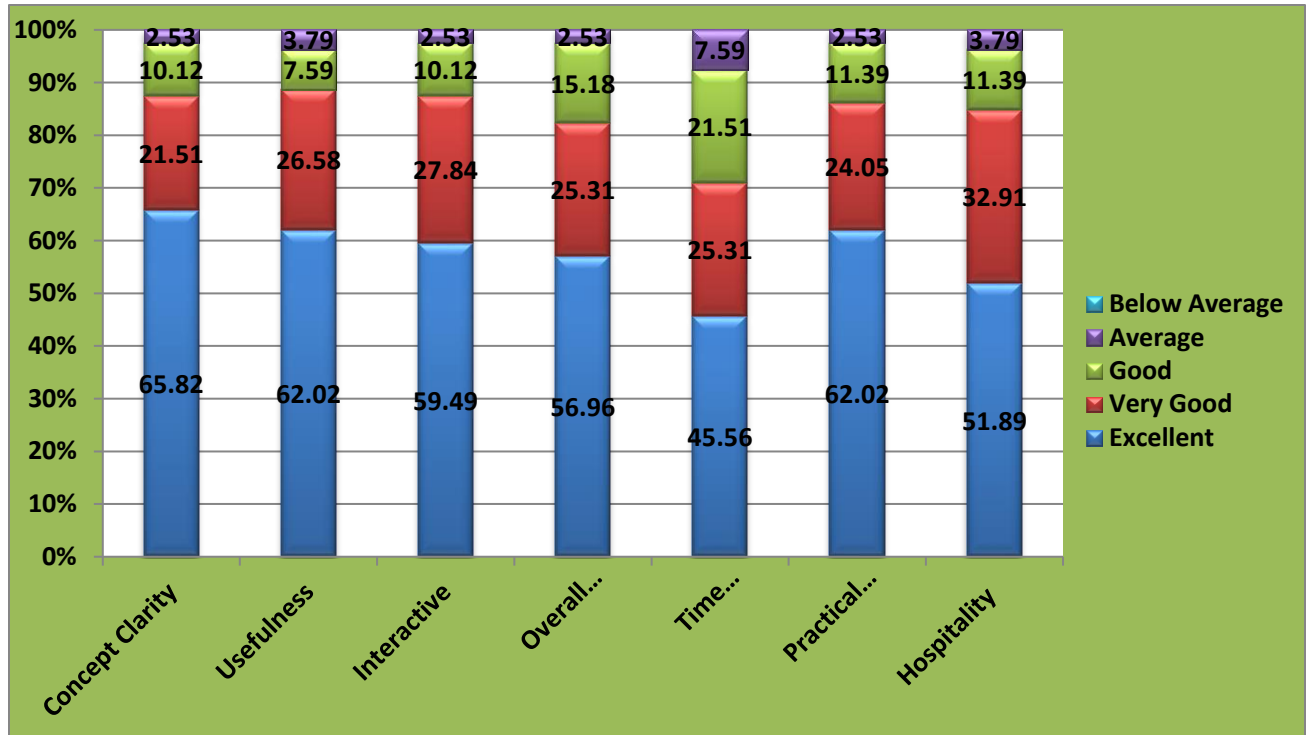
❖ **FEEDBACK**
