## PRINCIPAL'S MESSAGE

Presenting this issue of Vagishwari, a compilation of details about activities conducted in 2023-24, is a moment of pride for all of us. The activities reflect the unabated enthusiasm of faculty members and students to teach and learn through innovative means. Our teachers have always implemented novel methods of teaching and have held programmes to make students aware of socio-cultural issues and problems that plague our world. Hindi Department and Psychology Department collaborated with Dr BMN College of Home Science to organise two RUSA-sponsored programmes, one a workshop and other a faculty development programme.

Even with a hectic work-schedule, our teachers have devoted time for research and writing, which is reflected in their achievements. Noteworthy is a PhD earned by our senior faculty member Dr Madhavi Sathe in Food and Nutrition; Ms Apurva Ganu and Mayola Rogdrigues, faculty members of the Psychology Department, won 'The Best Research Paper' award at a national conference in Goa.

Our college has adopted Vani-cha-Pada, a tribal village in Goregaon E, where we conducted a number of educational programmes and awareness campaigns through the year. This community engagement has been mutually enriching for students and those who dwell in the village.

We now have four students' publications: Palavi (Marathi), Surabhi (Hindi), Beacon (Psychology) and Meteor (Management Studies). Besides, students have won prizes in marathon, debating, drawing, essay writing and so on. Our vibrant student community has always brought laurels to the institution. No words of praise and affection are enough for these young women.

I am thrilled to be amid a profound change in higher education in India. As one of the few autonomous colleges of Mumbai, we had the privilege of adopting the structural changes as recommended by the National Education Policy (2020). The new course structure recommended by the policy gives more freedom and flexibility to students, makes education inter-disciplinary, empowers Indian languages and covers co-curricular activities within the credited courses. These changes fulfil long-standing demands of intelligentsia who complained that Indian higher education restricts students in straightjackets, limits them to a single discipline at an early age, degrades Indian languages and places versatile students at a disadvantage. The policy makers have heeded these observations of academics who have exposure to educational milieu of various countries.

Our college has enthusiastically embraced the new era and decided to implement the NEP in its letter and spirit, for interdisciplinary education, language learning and deeper engagement in co-curricular activities will indeed provide a holistic development to future generations. We changed course structures of Humanities and Commerce; introduced innovative courses like Presentation Skills, Toy Making, Literature Masterclass, Happiness; we introduced credited courses like Personality Development, Yoga and Fitness, a course on environmental activities; and most important of all, we offered choices that previously did not exist.

I thank my colleagues of the teaching and administrative staff, who braced themselves for the NEP implementation by attending workshops, holding meetings and innovating the current academic and administrative systems. Their commitment to student community's welfare is exemplary. I thank all of them and express my gratitude to Seva Mandal Education Society, our management, whose unshakable faith and support have given me confidence to take the college forward.

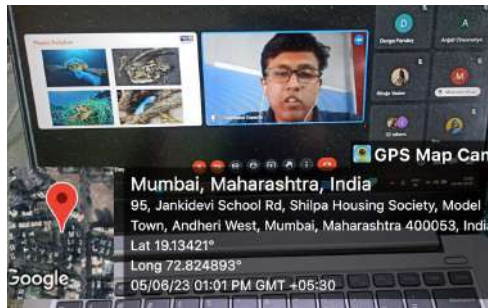

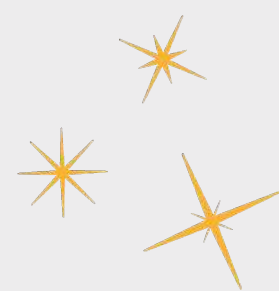

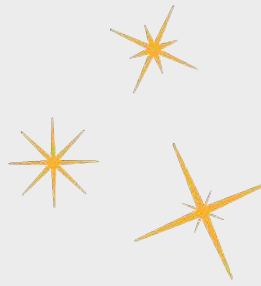
