

Drug Free Mumbai - Mass Oath Taking Program (30 July 2026)

On 30 July 2026, the “Drug Free Mumbai – Mass Oath-Taking Programme” was organised by *Nashamukti Janajagruti Abhiyan*, UP – Zonal Committee, in collaboration with the Government of Maharashtra and Mumbai Police, at NSCI Dome, Worli, Mumbai.

The initiative aimed to create mass awareness about the harmful effects of drug abuse, inspire youth and citizens to adopt a drug-free lifestyle, and take a collective pledge for a Drug Free Mumbai, Drug Free Maharashtra, and Drug Free India.

The college actively participated with 50 NSS Volunteers, 2 NSS Programme Officers and 2 Teachers. To ensure maximum involvement, the college also organised a live telecast in all smart classrooms, where more than 700 students, teaching and non-teaching staff joined the programme, took the online pledge, and received e-certificates under the *Nashamukti Abhiyan*.
