### **Teacher Feedback on Curriculum 2021-2022**

The curriculum feedback was taken from the teachers of the Commerce, Arts, Management and Mass Media faculty. The survey covered factors pertaining to curriculum framework and quality checks of the same. It included statements on the following factors:

- Appropriate credit and time allotment
- Training of students for higher education
- Scope for using a variety of teaching and evaluation tools
- Reference Books/ articles
- · Updation and upskilling of teachers
- Achievement of Program objectives, Program-specific objectives, and course objectives

As per the feedback received teachers have given average ratings for the factor of practical and skill training. Some feel that the syllabus is not yet completely providing opportunities for practical training of students and focuses only on theoretical foundations. This factor can be focused on in the further re-designing of the syllabus. For all other factors, teachers gave satisfactory feedback.
