BA Psychology Honours

Duration: 30 Hours Credits: 4

Objective: To go beyond the prescribed curriculum for comprehensive learning and overall development of the student

Process: TYBA students can volunteer to opt for the programme. The programme would be of four credits to be completed in one academic year. The programme would consist of following activities:

- 1. Two workshops to be attended in the academic year followed by Discussion. Each comprising of 2 credits (12 hours)
- 2. Completion of Group Research Project comprising of 2 credits (18 hours) OR

Participation in the Community Outreach Programme comprising of 2 credits (18 hours)

The student would be awarded the certificate on successful completion of BA and after earning all required credits.

Outcome:

- 1. Students learn how to apply classroom learning by undertaking research project or an outreach project
- 2. Students gain knowledge by participating in workshops conducted by experts from the industry. The workshops would give them a glimpse of Counselling therapies, thereby, generating their interest in Counselling Psychology. This would help in retaining students for our MA Counselling Psychology course.
- 3. It helps in overall development of the student, grooming them beyond their curricular requirements
