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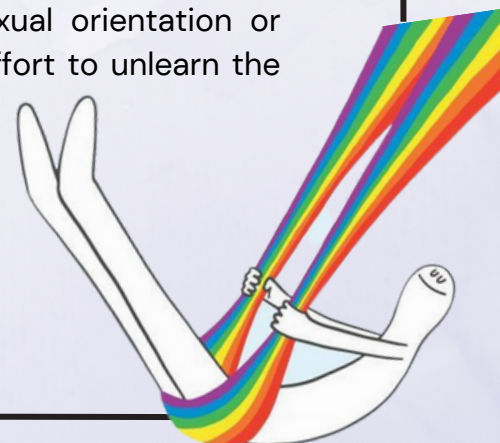
Allyship 101: Supporting and Empowering the LGBTQIA+ Community

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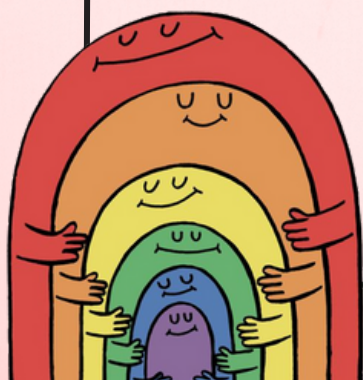


- **Listen**

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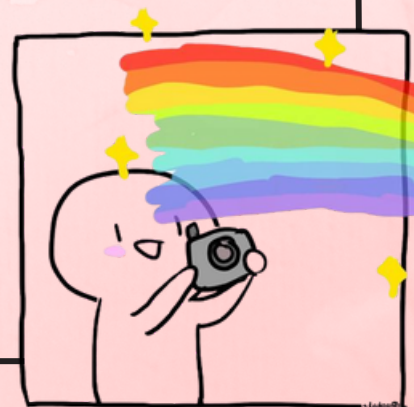


- **Stand Up Against Discrimination**

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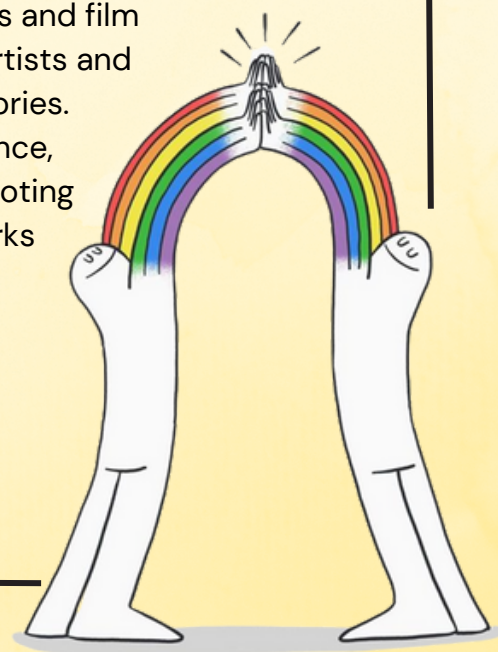


Pride Parades: A Beacon of Visibility and Empowerment:

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Community Engagement and Activism: Amplifying Voices for Change:

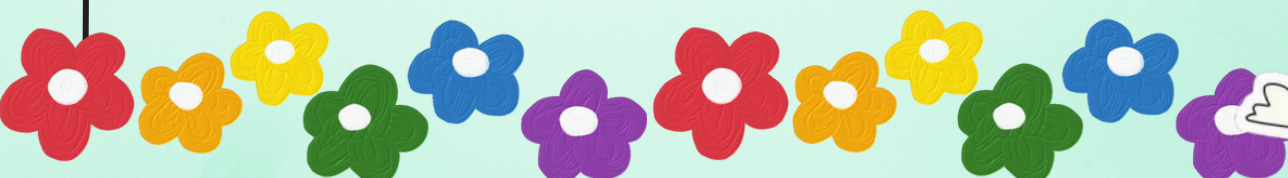

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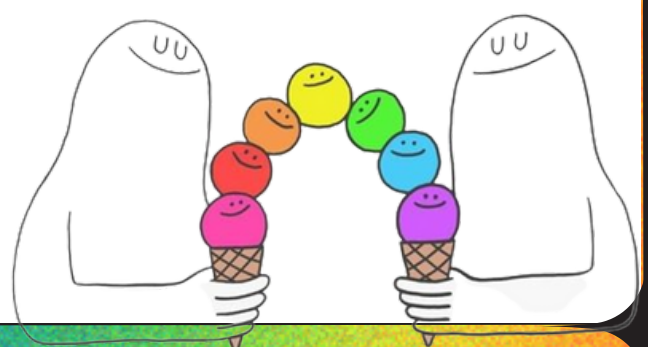
