A 3-day FDP on Digital Pedagogy: Digital Platforms for Successful Teaching was organised for all Degree College faculty members.

The IQAC- *Utthaan* organised the FDP along with College CDC member- Research- Professor Dr. Savitri Kulkarni. The resource person was Dr. Rajesh Idani, Quotient Consultancy.

The main objective of the FDP was to orient teachers to various aspects of digital pedagogy. This method will now be extensively used especially during the COVID 19 lockdown where online teaching has become essential. Soon colleges and schools may integrate face-to-face and online teaching and use them as Hybrid teaching pedagogy.

Through the three days, Dr. Rajesh and Dr. Savitri gave an overview of the digital platforms available for teaching-learning, the process of creating and uploading e-content and the ways in which the e-content created can be used as a means of promoting the college or the department.

A total of 49 faculty members along with Principal Dr. Leena Raje participated in the FDP. Each member or a group of teachers were given an assignment to submit a framework of the e-content they wish to develop keeping in mind the four quadrants of developing any content-Topic, Rationale, Flow and Outline.
